RE: Disc Golf Course Update

Having received the Parks & Recreation Committee's recommendation from their May 11 meeting as well as input from adjoining property owners, the City Council took action on the disc golf course expansion during their regular meeting on June 5. The City Council approved 4 motions in total:

- The City will moved forward with the disc golf course as staff time allows.
- Hole 5 and Pin 5 are not to be placed until the hole is realigned to the west.
- Staff is to create a special event permit for disc golf course use, and no additional tournaments (beyond the two already scheduled for 2023) are to be scheduled until the permit is approved by the City Council.
- The Planning Commission should continue the rezoning process for the 3 lots intended to be used as a parking lot.
 - o While the Council did have some discussion about reducing the size of the parking lot and planning for park amenities to be place in the extra space, they chose not to take any action on these items until the Planning Commission's recommendation on the rezoning comes before them. As such, no further work will be conducted on the parking lot until the City Council takes action on the issue.

The City Council made it clear that completion of the disc golf course and associated special event permit should only be done as staff time allows.

At this time, the City Council has not directed the Parks & Recreation Committee to take any further action on the disc golf course.
