RESOLUTION 39-2025

**RESOLUTION RECEIVING FEASIBILITY REPORT AND
CALLING HEARING ON IMPROVEMENT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to resolution of the council adopted October 6, 2025 a report has been prepared by WiDSETH with reference to proposed 2026 Street Improvements, the improvement of Bluebird Lane, Piney Way, and Wren Drive, and this report was received by the council on December 1, 2025, and

WHEREAS, the report provides information regarding whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels.¹

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF BREEZY POINT, MINNESOTA:

1. The council will consider the improvement of such streets in accordance with the report and the assessment of abutting property for all or a portion of the cost of the improvement pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 429 at an estimated total cost of the improvement of \$590,166.
2. A public hearing shall be held on such proposed improvement on the 5th day of January, 2026, in the council chambers of the city hall at 6:30 p.m. and the clerk shall give mailed and published notice of such hearing and improvement as required by law.
