



City of Breezy Point Mailbox Policy

Individual rural mailboxes are to be installed to proper specifications set forth by the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Transportation and the Postmaster.

1. The City of Breezy Point will not intentionally hit mailboxes.
2. Damage to a conforming mailbox and support as a result of negligence on the part of a city employee will be paid for by the City upon receipt of a Verified Claim provided no violations of any laws or ordinances are involved on the part of the box owner.
3. Damage to a non-conforming mailbox and support will be the responsibility of the Box owner, and the City will assume no responsibility.
4. Box owners are responsible for clearing snow from around their boxes to insure continued mail services.
5. As a part of a road improvement project, the City will replace existing mailboxes with MnDOT Standard Plate 9350B Swing-away type mailbox supports. It will be offered to the property owner to keep the original mailbox if they so choose. Existing conforming mailboxes may remain in place if construction activities do not require removal.
