RE: Disc Golf Course Bathrooms

### **Background**

One of the actions that the City Council approved regarding the disc golf course expansion during the January 2 City Council meeting was the placement of a portable bathroom on the north end of the course. As such, the Parks & Recreation Committee has been working with Public Works Supervisor Zierden on the best location for the bathroom in that area.

### **Placement of Portable Bathroom**

There are currently two portable bathrooms placed at the Monarch Trail and Agate Pass disc golf courses, one at the new parking lot on White Overlook Dr. and one at the old parking lot on Green Scene Dr.

While there were two documented incidences of public urination on the disc golf course expansion this spring, both occurred prior to the portable bathrooms being placed for the season. There have not been any documented cases or reports of public urination since the bathrooms were placed. Additionally, a number of the neighbors on the north side of the disc golf course expansion expressed displeasure with the prospect of a portable bathroom being placed behind their homes.

As there haven't been any reported issues with urination since the existing bathrooms were put in place, as a number of the neighbors are not in favor of one being placed on the north side of the course behind their homes, and as winter is now only a few months away, the Parks & Recreation Committee has submitted a recommendation to the City Council to not place a portable bathroom on the north side of the course now or in the spring. The Committee would like to watch and see how the rest of the 2024 season goes and how Spring 2025 goes as well.

### **Council Action**

Staff is requesting that the City Council consider the Parks & Recreation Committee's recommendation to not place a portable bathroom on the north side of the disc golf course.
