120 – Emergency Medical Services Program

120.1 POLICY

It is the policy of the Breezy Point Police Department, in concert with North Memorial Health (NMH), to operate an advanced emergency medical services program consisting of paramedics and emergency medical technicians (EMTs).

120.2 MEDICAL DIRECTION

Paramedics and EMTs employed by the Breezy Point Police Department may provide advanced emergency medical care if authorized by the Program Medical Director. NMH Ambulance – Office of Medical Directors. Medical care will be provided according to operating procedures and patient care guidelines provided approved by the program medical director. NMH Operating Procedures and Guidelines, in accordance the agreement between NMH and the City.

120.3 MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND MEDICATIONS

Medical equipment and medications will be provided and maintained in accordance with the agreement between NMH and the City. Paramedics and EMTs will be responsible for ensuring all equipment is ready for use at the beginning of each shift.

120.4 OFF DUTY RESPONSE

Paramedics and EMTs who learn of a call for medical assistance within the City of Breezy Point or any area the Breezy Point Police Department is responsible for providing service, while offduty, may go in-service and respond to such call. In the event of a medical callout, the employee will receive a minimum of two hours of compensation.
