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### **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION**

Below are some possible road combinations for 2026 with brief description to help with the selection process.

1. Circle Drive (\$172,000), Camp Lora Place (\$55,000), Sand Beach Drive (\$120,000) = \$347,000
  - 4736 sq/yd
  - Ratings of 4-5
  - Very weathered
  - Lower traffic/low speeds
  - Requires annual maintenance
  - Residential areas/public beach
2. Thrane Drive = \$355,000
  - 6191 sq/yd
  - Rating 4
  - Very weathered and frequent shoulder erosion
  - Average to higher traffic
  - Requires more frequent pothole repair and shoulder repair
  - Bordered by vacant property
  - Collector road (not assessable)
3. West Street = \$380,000
  - 6680 sq/yd
  - Rating 4
  - Very weathered
  - Average to higher traffic
  - Requires pothole filling 2 to 3 times per year
  - Residential area with some vacant land bordering West Street (Buschmann's field)
4. Beverly Drive (\$75,000), East Street (\$125,000), Rolling Oaks Trail (\$65,000), Russ Court (\$85,000) = \$350,000
  - 12,399 sq/yd
  - 2.5 avg rating
  - Generally better condition, cracks depressing
  - Consistent year-round residential traffic
  - Residential area
