Subject: Construction Contract for Smart Corridors Northern Cities

Community Goal/Result: Fiscally Prudent

Purpose

To complete the installation of components of an intelligent transportation system to guide overflow traffic winding through Brisbane during freeway closures. This project follows on to the installation of fiber optic that has been underway in Bayshore Boulevard, and will include the installation of an interconnected traffic signal system, closed-circuit television (CCTV) cameras, dynamic message signs, and vehicle detection system.

Recommendation

Award the Smart Corridors Northern Cities - Brisbane construction contract (Project No. 924D) to Bear Electrical Solutions, Inc. in the amount of \$2,915,935 and authorize the mayor to sign the Agreement on behalf of the City.

Environmental Review

This contract is part of an overall project that was subject to CEQA and NEPA review. Caltrans approved a Categorical Exemption and a Categorical Exclusion for the project on August 31, 2020.

Background: The city received three bids on August 15, 2024:

Bear Electrical Solutions, Inc.	\$2,915,935.00
ENGINEER'S ESTIMATE	\$3,028,750.00
Tennyson Electric, LLC	\$3,183,675.00 ¹
Bay Area Lightworks, Inc.	\$3,602,925.00

The apparent low bidder's proposal is responsive, and the bidder is responsible.


Fiscal Impact

A Funding Agreement between the City/County Association of Governments of San Mateo County and the City of Brisbane was executed March 1, 2024. That agreement provided funding of \$3,211,697.00 for all the components of this contract.
