Subcommittee Update

From April 29th, 2023 to May 12th, 2023

Public Art Advisory Committee 5/1 Cunningham, Davis

The Committee received a presentation from Phase 3 regarding their proposed private art installation. The Committee members asked questions about the proposed artists and suggested that the art play on light and shadows and be representative of all genders. At a future meeting, Phase 3 will provide a complete package presentation including placement, scale, and budget.

Staff provided the quarterly Public Art Fund report showing \$1.85M available. The Committee asked about any remaining amount committed for the Midtown Mural. Staff will follow up.

Staff presented the Final RFP review with process schedule before recommendation to Council. The Committee recommended unanimously to bring forward to Council at their 5/18 meeting.

The Committee reviewed and discussed the Art implementation guidelines. They discussed whether the ordinance could/should include a provision for performance-based (non-permanent) art. Staff was directed to investigate what other cities do and to receive guidance from the City Attorney. The Committee understands that any future proposed changes to the Guidelines/Ordinance requires Council approval.

The Committee discussed small scale projects including Sidewalk Chalk event, Film festival, revitalization of Firth Park art, Surprise Art, a “Push Pin” party as a “day in the life” of Brisbane, and a bench art project. The Committee wishes to clarify through the City Attorney whether non-permanent art events/displays can be facilitated within the existing guidelines. Staff will follow up.

Sierra Point Parkway Design Guidelines Subcommittee 5/3 Lentz, O’Connell

Staff discussed with the subcommittee BDI’s Hotel and Biotech application that has been submitted. A concern is around pedestrian access and traffic circulation to/from and around the project. In response to the City, the applicant gave three different scenarios, but it doesn’t fully address all of the City’s concerns. The subcommittee gave some suggestions (create a roundabout on south/east corner and cantilever the lower level on the westside) and direction (no entry/exit to be on City property on eastside) to staff to assist the applicant through the process.
