Subcommittee Update

Liaison to Complete Streets Safety Committee 10/23

The subcommittee discussed options for starting a parking program. They considered enforcement either throughout central Brisbane or targeted streets and then whether to go with a third-party vendor or handle it in-house. Due to the cost of implementing the full program, it was suggested to have a third option, which is to modify or strengthen our current program and setting expectations that it may take time for enforcement to follow up on a complaint. There could be a soft one-year roll-out to begin registering cars per household and leave it as complaint based. The subcommittee then discussed how registration would work, guest passes and whether enforcement would be between certain hours such as 12am-5am, so as not to impede visiting guests during the day and evening hours. Staff will bring this topic to the Council in January which will include suggestions such as proposing a soft roll-out and beginning on targeted streets.

Liaison to Open Space & Ecology Committee 10/24

The Subcommittee reviewed the draft Invasive Species Ordinance prepared by OSEC. They discussed how the program would work, differences between residential vs commercial properties, mechanism to collect fines, would there be levels of fines and how the City's properties will be managed. Council liaisons suggested a soft roll-out to include an educational program and would like a more robust compliance schedule.
