Subject: Award of 2024 Slurry Seal Contract (Project No. 924G)

This work is categorically exempt from CEQA per CCR Title 14 §15302.

Recommendation: Award the construction contract for the 2024 Slurry Seal to VSS International, Inc. in the amount of \$313,211.00, and authorize the Mayor to sign the Agreement for the City.

Background and Discussion

The City solicited bids for the City's slurry seal project for 2025. The project includes striping of a new bike lane on Old County Road. The City received three bids on July 2, 2025:

VSS International	\$313,211.00
American Asphalt Repair	\$321,515.00
Pavement Coatings Co.	\$328,157.00

Staff reviewed the apparent low bid and determined that the proposal was responsive, and the bidder was responsible. Impacts to transit users, pedestrians, cyclists, and the motoring public will be minimal during construction, which is expected to begin in August 2025. The contractor will be required to keep one lane of traffic open during work on Old County Rd. at all times.

Environmental Review

The pavement project is categorically exempt from provisions of CEQA in that the proposals are replacement or reconstruction of existing uses on the same site as the existing facilities with no change in purpose or expansion of capacity (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Division 6, Chapter 3, Article 19, §15302 "Class 2 – Replacement or Reconstruction").

Fiscal Impact: 2023-2024 RMRA Funds and Measure A Sales Tax and State Gas Tax revenues will fund this project.
