Subject: Ad Hoc Quarry Development Subcommittee

Community Goal/Result

Economic Development - Brisbane will work with the businesses and residents to provide for economic vitality/diversity

Purpose

To provide guidance and support to staff over the course of the project

Recommendation

Create an ad hoc council subcommittee on Quarry Development matters

Background and Discussion

In early October of this year, the City released an environmental impact report (EIR) for the development known as the [Guadalupe Quarry Development Project](#) (the Quarry). The comment period for the EIR runs for 60 days, through December 6, 2024. Comments received by the City will be responded to over the course of the winter, with associated meetings on the application to follow.

Council participation is critical during the project's process. To that end, staff requests that the City Council create an ad hoc subcommittee that will meet as needed to discuss a range of issues, including progress on the EIR, meeting schedules, development agreements, and other elements of such a project. Staff requests that the City Council also appoint two members to the ad hoc subcommittee.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with the creation of this ad hoc subcommittee.

Measure of Success

An ad hoc subcommittee is a temporary subcommittee formed to address a specific issue or task, dissolving once the Guadalupe Quarry Development Project EIR review is completed.
