**Subject:** The Chamber of Commerce "The Showbroads" Application for Event

Cosponsorship

#### Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the Brisbane Chamber of Commerce's "The Showbroads" application for a cosponsored event.

## **Background**

The Brisbane Chamber of Commerce (Chamber) is a Non-profit 501(c)(6) organization created through a partnership of businesses, civic leaders, and residents working together to enhance Brisbane's economic landscape. The Chamber assisted small businesses throughout the COVID-19 pandemic with critical information about protocols and funding opportunities and partnered with the City of Brisbane to distribute grants. The Chamber continues to print The Luminary (Brisbane's only newspaper), offer scholarships to college students, partner with Lipman Middle School on a job shadowing day, create wooden holiday stars for residents, and sponsor the Brisbane Garden Show.

### Discussion

"The Showbroads", will be held on Saturday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025 from 6:30-8:30pm at the Mission Blue Center. The event will include a cabaret performance with refreshments and is structured as a fundraiser for the Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber of Commerce qualifies under the Group II category for recreation facilities indoor use permits as a non-profit group serving the Brisbane community. Meeting the Group II requirements with the event open to the general public qualifies the Chamber for free use of the facility and waives the deposit requirement.

### **Fiscal Impact**

The Brisbane Chamber of Commerce is requesting support from the City as summarized in the table below. Use of the facility and the deposit would be waived as part of their Group III designation.
