### **Community Goal/Result**

Community Building & Fundraising

### **Purpose**

Promote cultural and social events that encourage community engagement and provide assistance to local non-profit organizations.

### Recommendation

Approve the San Bruno Mountain Watch (SBMW) Solstice Gathering as a cosponsored event.

### **Background**

San Bruno Mountain Watch a is Non-profit 501(c)(3) organization established in 1995. Their mission is to care for San Bruno Mountain through conservation, ecological restoration, education, and advocacy in partnership with local communities. SBMW engages local communities, including Brisbane residents, in efforts to protect and restore the mountain including habitat workdays. They also teach the community about the cultural and natural history of the mountain and provide them with native plants from the Mission Blue Nursery. The Mission Blue Nursery provides opportunities to learn about and participate in native plant propagation and environmental horticulture.

### Discussion

The SBMW Solstice Gathering event will be held at the Brisbane Community Park on Saturday, June 21, 2025 from 2:00-9:00pm. The event will include exhibits about San Bruno Mountain, educational and art activities, a potluck picnic, discussion tables, and plant displays. Please refer to the Event Summary attachment for a detailed outline. Admission is free to the general public. Meeting the Group II requirements with the event open to the general public qualifies them for free use of the outdoor facility and waives the deposit requirement.

### Fiscal Impact

San Bruno Mountain Watch is requesting support from the City as summarized in the table below. They have requested use of the Brisbane Community Park for the aforementioned event. Use of the facility and the deposit are waived as part of their Group II designation.

# San Bruno Mountain Solstice Gathering Saturday, June 21st, 2025 2pm-9pm Brisbane, California Brisbane Community Park

### **Event Summary**

San Bruno Mountain Watch proposes to host a gathering on Saturday, June 21st, 2025, to celebrate the summer solstice and the life of San Bruno Mountain. The event will be free and open to the public.

The organization, in partnership with the City of Brisbane, will set up a variety of activities, exhibits, and gathering areas at the Brisbane Community Park.

### **Activities**

- San Bruno Mountain Makerspace: San Bruno Mountain Watch staff and volunteers will bring supplies and facilitate a variety of arts and crafts activities, such as:
  - Wreath-making with San Bruno Mountain native plants
  - Botanical watercoloring
  - o Making clay caterpillars ("clayterpillars") models of the San Bruno elfin butterfly
  - Decorating face-masks with images of San Bruno Mountain flora and fauna
  - Environmental poetry
  - Painting of terra-cotta pots
- **Art Exhibits**: San Bruno Mountain Watch will display printed examples of San Bruno Mountain art and photography on outdoor A-frames.
- **Educational Exhibits**: San Bruno Mountain Watch will set up tables with educational exhibits, posters, books, and booklets about the cultural and natural history of San Bruno Mountain.
- Native Plant Display and Sale: San Bruno Mountain Watch's Mission Blue Nursery will
  display a selection of beautiful San Bruno Mountain native plants and offer them for sale.
  Some plants will also be given away for free. Other merchandise, such as mountain
  posters, prints, books, and stickers, will also be available.

- **Discussion Tables**: San Bruno Mountain Watch will set up discussion tables for people to chat about San Bruno Mountain, such as memories of the mountain, favorite trails, mountain conservation efforts, and more. Some tables will feature invited guests such as authors of books on the flora, fauna, and history of San Bruno Mountain, County Park rangers, and others who work on or research San Bruno Mountain.
- **Sunset Hike**: A guided evening walk will be offered, leading interested people from the Brisbane Community Park through Quarry Road to Buckeye Canyon, where participants will hike to the ridge of the mountain and watch the sunset.
- **Potluck and Picnics**: San Bruno Mountain Watch will encourage attendees to bring a communal dish to share with people at the event. We will also provide a selection of snacks, drinks, and food for free to those who attend.
- **Fire Ring:** If permissible, San Bruno Mountain Watch will rent a gas-powered, portable fire-ring, so that participants can gather around the fire, sing songs, and enjoy the warmth.
- **Music:** San Bruno Mountain Watch will invite local and regional musicians to play music throughout the event. The music will not be greatly amplified.
