# **Community Goal/Result**

Community Building

## Purpose

Promote cultural and social events that encourage community engagement and provide assistance to local non-profit organizations.

### Recommendation

Approve the Bright Minds Africa Swim-a-Thon as a co-sponsored event.

## Background

Bright Minds Africa is a non-profit organization that provides a school partnership program at Lipman Middle School. One of their founders, Gina Dettmer, is a Brisbane resident. The mission of Bright Minds Africa is to empower girls and remove the obstacles that prevent them from accessing education, including family dynamics, community needs, and social issues like early marriage. Bright Minds Africa achieves this through various programs, including:

- Education: Identifying out-of-school children and working with their families to enroll them, providing scholarships, and supporting local schools with teacher training and infrastructure.
- Literacy: Developing libraries in schools and communities to combat functional illiteracy and offer literacy programming.
- Healthcare: Addressing malnutrition, HIV transmission, and maternal health issues through various interventions.
- Other Initiatives: Providing clean water projects, microloans, and mentorship.

Currently, Lipman students engage in a pen pal exchange program with students in Nigeria and fundraise for communities throughout West Africa. Through Bright Minds Africa, Brisbane residents have the opportunity to sponsor students in Nigeria and partake in an annual donor dinner.

### Discussion

Bright Minds Africa's inaugural Swim-a-Thon event is being proposed for Saturday, June 7, 2025, from 3:30-7:00pm at the Brisbane Community Pool. The event set up would begin at 2:30pm and clean up would be completed by 7:15pm. Lifeguards would be onsite throughout the duration of the event. The

event would consist of community members registering in advance and swimming laps to raise funds to donate towards construction of a High School for girls in Nigeria.
