Criminal Enforcement: September brought us several investigations, having investigated 39 cases and 3 of those cases were closed by immediate arrest. Two OWI – Felony arrests, 1 theft, 1 criminal trespass, 1 warrant arrest, 1 resisting law enforcement and 2 criminal trespass, 1 criminal mischief, 1 burglary, 1 criminal recklessness and 1 possession of marijuana. We continue to investigate several cases from this and previous months. As always, we wish to remind everyone that there are still many scams or attempts. Always know who you are dealing with and never give out pertinent information over the phone.

Traffic Enforcement: In September officers investigated 11 vehicle crashes. Officers issued 39 traffic citations, addressing speed, signal and sign violations. There were 7 of our citations that were for driving while license suspended or never receiving a license. They also issued 48 written warning tickets. As always, please drive defensively and never text and drive. Always wear safety restraints properly – **THEY DO SAVE LIVES.**
