The No-Knock Registry has been established under Richmond Town Code of Ordinance Chapter 5.20.070 and is a voluntary Program that helps protect the safety and privacy of residents by reducing un-announced visits to your home.

Owners/Occupants of residences may register for the No-Knock Registry by submitting a request form available in the Town Clerk's Office. This registry shall be made available to licensed solicitors and law enforcement.

Good morning, all,

At the July 21st Town Council Meeting, the Richmond Town Council voted to approve amendments to Town Ordinance 5.20 entitled "Hawkers, Peddlers and Door to Door Salespersons", adding section 5.20.070 entitled "Door-to-door Commercial Solicitation: Regulation of Door-to-door Commercial Solicitation". This ordinance defines commercial solicitation and establishes a No-Knock Registry that residents may sign up for to prohibit door-to-door commercial solicitation. Residents complete an application provided by the Town Clerk's Office that is updated quarterly and sent to any door-to-door salesperson who holds a license within the Town of Richmond. 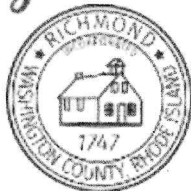
