IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of Bristol, Rhode Island, that Chapter 16 of the Ordinances of the Town of Bristol be amended as follows:

Sec. 16-114. Stop intersections designated.

The following intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections and all vehicles shall stop before entering the same:

(2) *Four-way stop intersections:*

Coggeshall Avenue and Platt Street

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

The Town Council will be in session in the Town Hall, Council Chambers, on September 16, 2026. If remonstrance in the meantime, a petition bearing the valid signatures of at least twenty (20) qualified voters must be filed with the Town Clerk requesting a Public Hearing, such hearing must be held before final action may be taken on said ordinance.
