NOTES:

I spoke with Mr. Martucci regarding this request. He stated that there will be no changes made to the bar area; however, he is requesting to add outside seating. I explained to Mr. Martucci that the outside seating must be used in conjunction with tables and dining and may not be used solely for the consumption of alcoholic beverages. For example, patrons may not purchase an alcoholic beverage, take it outside, and consume it while waiting for a table to dine. Mr. Martucci stated that he understood and confirmed that this is not his intention. After reviewing this petition, there is no known reason for denial of the Class BV liquor license transfer, provided that all guidelines set forth in the application, as well as all applicable laws and ordinances governing this practice, are followed. I recommend a six-month review continued
