Deputy Chief Danny Cheatom

- ★ Reported that Engine 3's ladder rack is wobbling, and the PA system is not working.
- ★ Requested that a motion sensor be installed on the shed in the rear yard at the Defiance.

Assistant Chief Barry Carinha

- * Reported that the overhead door in Engine 1's bay has been repaired.
- ★ Chief DeMello stated that the new refrigerator for the apparatus room should be delivered on Friday, July 1st.
- * Regarding the ball on Engine 10, Marc Proulx will be traveling to Maine to retrieve it.
- ★ The ice container will be delivered on Wednesday June 29th.

Assistant Chief John Paul Perry

- ★ Discussed obtaining propane for the July 4th Celebration. All tanks should be refilled at Sunshine Energy & Fuels.
- ★ Inquired about the routine maintenance for Marine 1 & 7.

Battalion Chief Jim Vieira (Safety & Training)

- ★ Announced that the Pump Course is in its final stages, with only a few classes remaining.
- ★ The next Firefighter I Class is being delayed. This is due to a request from the State Fire Academy.
- ★ Preparation Classes for the aforementioned class will be held after Labor Day in September.
- ★ Asked the board if they had, or could obtain names for the next Firefighter I Class.
- ★ It was asked if the next class would be done by the department, could the junior firefighters could attend. This was approved.
- Regarding the storage units at former Tweets property, the department may be obtaining the existing buildings for training before being taken down. Assistant Chief Perry inquired whether any buildings were sprinklered, so that the department could utilize them for "sprinklered building training".

Lieutenant Brad Palmer (Division of Emergency Medical Services)

- ★ With the new Rescue vehicle due to arrive on Wednesday June 29th, everything is in place to be placed on it, as soon as it arrives.
- ★ Chief DeMello stated that he has scheduled an inspection with the state to be conducted on Thursday June 30th.

★ Stated that the recent Firemen's Memorial Sunday went well.

New Business

- ★ There will be no overnight details on the 3rd, all 4th details will resume on the morning of the 4th.
- ★ The Fire Police details are in place.
- ★ The details for the fireworks will follow previous years operations.
- ★ Chief DeMello discussed with the board the radio channel operations for the 4th.
