

June 6, 2022**

Dom Franco called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

1. May meeting minutes were approved.
2. Harbor Management Plan – Bristol Harbor Management Plan has been approved and an E-Mail copy has been sent to everyone. We will soon start working on next plan update.
3. Review of Latest Fuel Dock & Marina Status – Gregg advises fuel dock & New Marina are open and operating in May 2022. Work continues to get everything operating such as water and electrical. We anticipate having clean water by July 8, 2022. Ribbon cutting ceremony to be held on 6/15/22.
4. CRMC – File # 2022-04-046 discussed in detail and final approval will be voted on June 13, 2022 at Special Meeting.
5. Report of the Harbormaster
 - A. Boating Safety Course – Gregg to hold as soon as he can in June.
 - B. Stare St Ramp & Ind Park Launch Docks – Gregg M advises no change.
 - C. Dock Repair & Maintenance – Progress continues. Bob Booth is working on.
 - D. Maritime Center Sign for Building – Gregg M advises sign is designed. One for the North and one for the West. Should be ordered in June.
 - E. Trash Skimmer – Gregg will send follow-up E-Mail.
 - F. Wait List for Marina – down to approximately 150 names.
 - G. Dinghy Dock Winter Rates – Torre Petersen & Bob Hamel submitted draft proposal & we discussed at June meeting! We will discuss again at July meeting.



- H. Gibson Rd ROW Ramp Repair – progress continues & Ed Tanner continues working on with BHIA.
 - I. ROWS – Steve C advises Town continues working on upgrades.
 - J. State St Parking Lot – Police Dept will work on striping parking lot when Fuel Dock is complete.
 - K. Fales Rd ROW Marker – Gregg M looked at washout and will work on repair.
 - L. Fishing Regulation Signs - will be posted. Lifelines will be on installed on appropriate docks & ladders.
6. Ferry Rd Signage – Kevin Cute advises we’re just waiting to hear from DOT and we’ll be free to have the signage installed immediately afterward.
