**SUBJECT : 4-WAY STOP REQUEST COGGESHALL AVENUE AT
PLATT STREET**

Sir,

At your request, I reviewed the intersection of Platt Street at Coggeshall Avenue in response to a request to install a four-way stop at this location. It is my understanding that a construction project at 54 Coggeshall Avenue has been approved, including reduced setbacks from the roadway and intersection visibility may be of concern.

Currently, traffic on Platt Street is controlled by a stop sign, while Coggeshall Avenue has no traffic control devices. I conducted an on-site assessment of the intersection from all approaches and observed no visibility obstructions. Additionally, we have found no reports of motor vehicle collisions or traffic violations at this intersection during the last three years reviewed.

It should be noted that the existing crash history and traffic conditions alone may not support a four-way stop under our guidelines, however, consideration should be given to the concerns raised by residents regarding the approved construction project and its potential effect on visibility at this intersection.

Based on these considerations, the Bristol Police Department has no objection to the approval and installation of a four-way stop at this intersection.

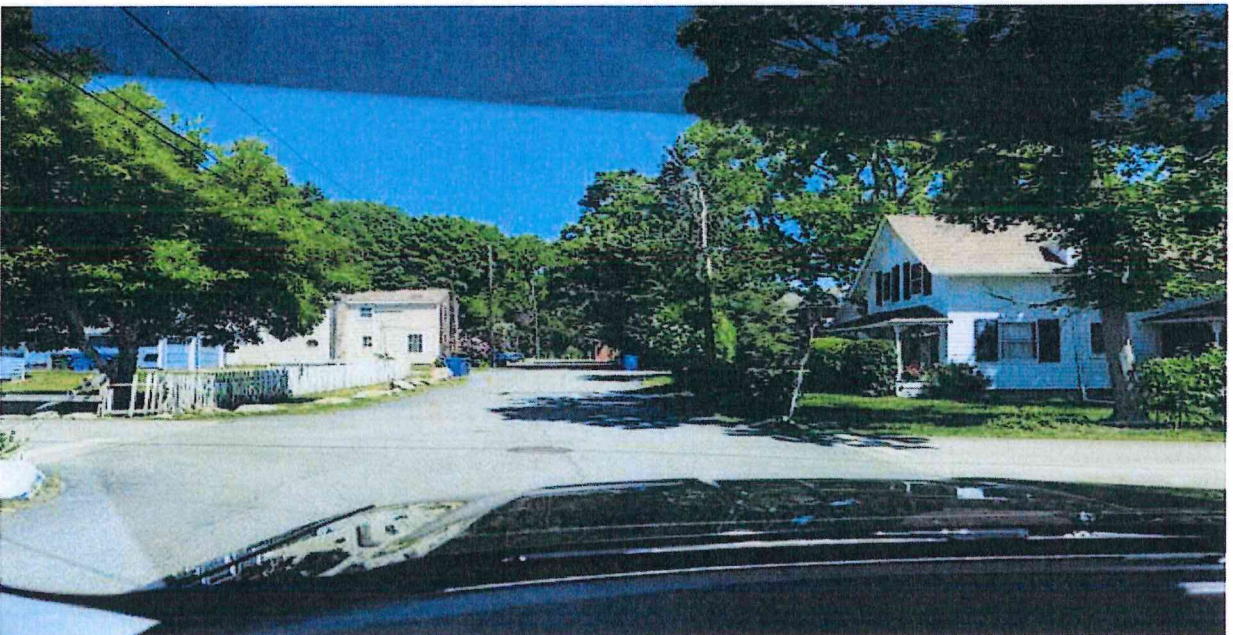
