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I spoke with Mr. Crouch about the petition and my concerns with the proposed location of the food truck. As planned, the truck would be parked in a parking space with a service window facing north, which would require guests to step into the parking area and roadway to order and pick up their food.

I suggested moving the food truck into Quito's parking lot and reserving two parking spaces for it. This would allow the service window to face Independence Park, making it safer and more convenient for guests to access the truck without having to walk through traffic. Mr. Crouch didn't have any issues with relocating the food truck and was open to the suggestion.

There is no known reason for denial of this license, provided that all laws and ordinances governing this practice are followed.
