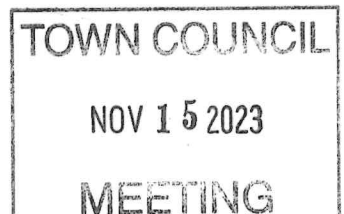

This ordinance shall take place upon its passage.

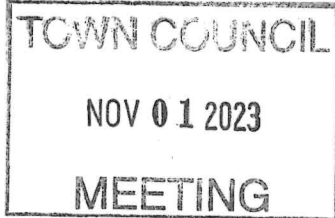
