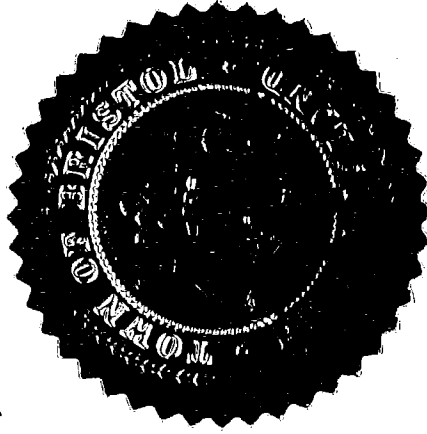
WHEREAS, Officers make the ultimate sacrifice every day, while on patrol; and
