WHEREAS Officers make the ultimate sacrifice every day, while on patrol; and

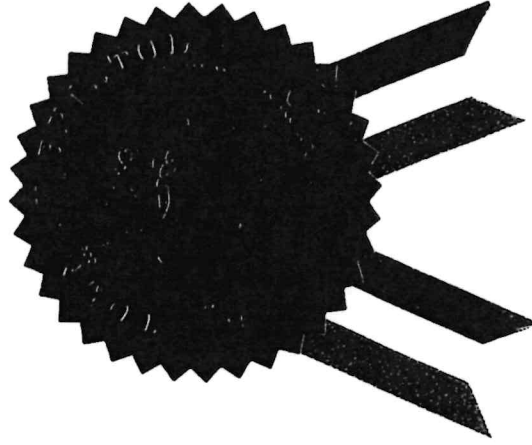
WHEREAS it is important that we come together as a community to show our support for our police officers, express our gratitude for their service, and remember those who have fallen.

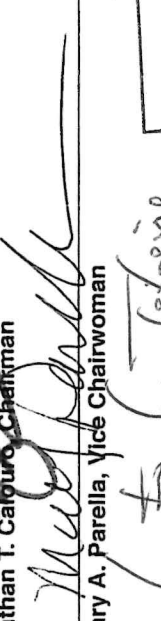

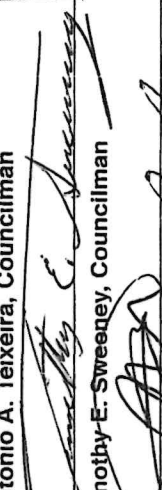
