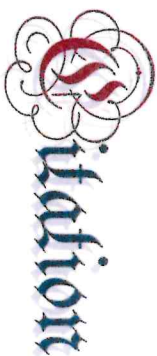

Candace “Candy” Pansa


