My father, John F. Lunney Jr. (deceased) had handled this with former Town Administrator Halsey Henneschoff (from what I can recollect, as I was a teenager at the time.

We obviously want to be in compliance and we respectfully request to be able to continue having our "No Parking" designation during business hours from Monday - Friday 9-5. It is our hope that with the existing signage (Curb loading zone) in addition to the painted lines, that this will be approved. It is absolutely essential, especially during certain times of the year, that our customers and delivery trucks have access to this space as there is literally no other area for them.
