 - C. Dock Repair & Maintenance – progress continues. Docks at Ind. park will be rebuilt this Spring. Fixed piers will be rebuilt this Summer.
 - D. Maritime Center Sign for Building – Gregg M advises sign design is being revised and will be reported on in Dec.
 - E. Trash Skimmer – Gregg M to follow- up in Dec.
 - F. Waitlist for Marina – still growing now at 169 names on list.
 - G. Dinghy Dock Winter Storage Rate – stays the same.
