# PETITION TO THE TOWN COUNCIL

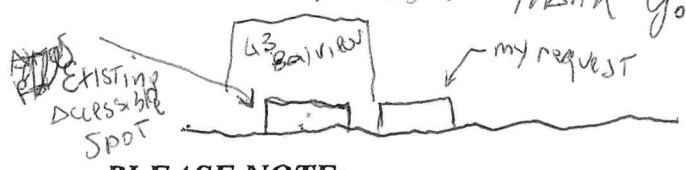
To the Honorable Town Council of the Town of Bristol: The undersigned hereby respectfully requested of your Honorable Body that:

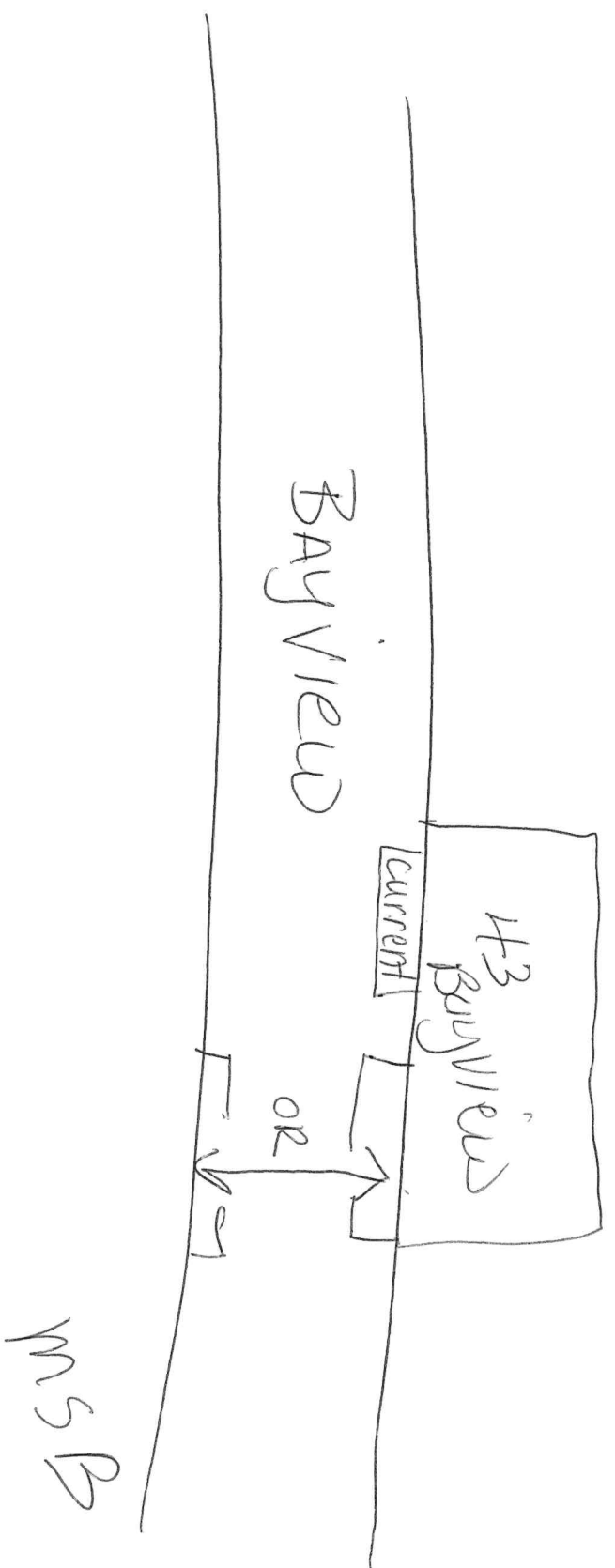
