

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

### COOPERATIVE HUNTER-LANDOWNER MANAGEMENT PLAN

This Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA") is made this 11 day of June 2026 by and between the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management ("DEM"), Division of Fish and Wildlife (the "Division"), and the Town of Bristol, (collectively the "Parties") to allow archery deer hunting on four town properties: Minturn, Hopeworth, Skaters Pond and 100 Acre Woods. The Parties agree to participate in perpetuity unless a new MOA is established. Either of the undersigned "Parties" may withdraw from participation of this program by giving a thirty (30) day written notice with cause, resulting in termination of this agreement between the Town of Bristol and the Division.

This MOA is executed in duplicate and each copy, thereof, shall be deemed original.

### DESCRIPTION OF LAND DESIGNATED FOR PUBLIC HUNTING

The Town of Bristol is the fee owner of four separate properties located in the Town of Bristol, County of Bristol, State of Rhode Island, more particularly listed and described in Exhibit A, which is attached and incorporated herein (hereinafter referred to as the "Premises"). This Premises is further described in the Deer Management Plan for Town of Bristol, included as Exhibit B, attached hereto, and incorporated herein.

Tax Parcels for each property are listed below,

1. Minturn: 171-25:91 acres, 144-6: 1.96 acres, 144-7: 2.93 acres, 144-3: 7.8 acres, 144-4: 11 acres, 144-5: 4 acres, 144-8: 1.5 acres, 144-9: 2 acres, 144-10: 3 acres, 144-11: 1 acre, 144-12: 2 acres, 144-13: 1 acre, 144-14: 5.8 acres, 135-3: 41.3 acres (an additional ~3.5 acres of this parcel to the south of Tower St will be NOT open), 144-1: 6.5 acres, 144-2: 17.6 acres, 144-15: 11 acres (This was subdivided from a parcel that was originally 22.5 acres, but the rest was retained by Brown and is NOT open)
2. Hopeworth: 156-116: 20.16 acres, 145-21: 15.36 acres, 145-112: 6.91 acres, 145-107: 0.12 acres, 145-N.A. Clipper Way ROW: 1.28
3. Skaters Pond: 108-1: 6.36 acres, 108-67: 15.19 acres, 108-11: 4.10 acres, 112-100: 1.48 acres
4. 100 Acre Woods: 89-2: 8.29 acres, 89-57: 6.07 acres, 89-3: 27.14 acres, 89-70: 1.11 acres 92-89: 13.22 acres, 90-67: 11.31 acres, 92-74: 38.67 acres

- A. Allow public archery deer hunting on the Premises;
- B. Assist in the detection of violators of law on the Premises.

### AGREED TO BY THE DIVISION

Pursuant to this MOA, the Division agrees to the following:

- A. Establish and enforce DEM regulations;
- B. Indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Bristol in case of any injury resulting from hunting use of the Premises.

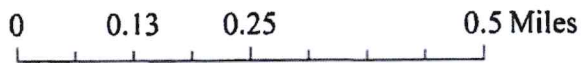

# Town of Bristol Minturn Archery Deer Hunting





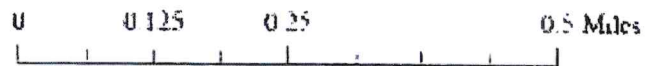

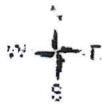

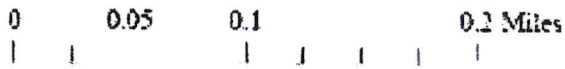

**Deer Management Plan for Town of Bristol**

**Open four town properties; Minturn, Hopeworth, Skaters Pond and 100 Acre Woods for Archery Deer Hunting on Town of Bristol property located throughout the town of Bristol in Cooperation with R.I. DEM Division of Fish and Wildlife (DFW)**

**Purpose:** To assist the Town of Bristol reduce deer abundance through legal regulated archery hunting.

**Project Area:** The four properties are Minturn, Hopeworth, Skaters Pond and 100 Acre Woods can be seen in Exhibit A.

**Minturn:** Parking and access may occur between poles 24 and 26 and along the field on the south side of Tower Steet. Hunters shall only hunt in the wooded section and fields within the boundary but may utilize the access road within the boundary seen in Exhibit A.

**Hopeworth:** Parking and access may occur from Annawamscutt Boat Ramp or Hopeworth Ave.

**Skaters Pond:** Parking and access may occur on Peter Road.

**100 Acre Woods:** Parking and access may occur at the end of Elmwood Drive, end of Jameson Drive, and parking area on San Francisco Drive.

**Proposed Management:** To reduce deer abundance and associated negative impacts, the DFW and the town will open said properties to archery deer hunting. As members of the Bristol Town Council are concerned for public safety, archers must obtain an Archery Proficiency Card prior to hunting any of the said properties.

**Terms:** The Division of Fish and Wildlife will maintain signage posting entrance areas stating that archery deer hunting is occurring. This management agreement shall be in effect in perpetuity. During the period of agreement changes in management practices may be discussed and agreed upon before implementation. Any modifications to the agreement must be in writing and agreed to by both parties. Either party may cancel this agreement with written notice showing cause thirty (30) days prior to termination.

**Schedule:** Annually in September, the DFW will post entrance areas with DEM/DFW signs if they have been removed.
