RE: **CRMC PUBLIC NOTICE 2025-12-079, HERRESHOFF MARINE MUSEUM
1 BURNSIDE STREET, BRISTOL, R.I.**

At our Harbor Commission meeting on March 2, 2026, the Commission reviewed and discussed Public Notice 2025-12-079; the reconfiguration within their marina permitter line. This reconfiguration would remove 11 of their moorings, create 75 total slips, fixed pier, wave fence and concrete floats.

The commission approves and our recommendations are as follows:

1. Adequate Pump Out Stations to handle all boat sizes in the marina.
2. If new moorings are requested, they would need to reapply.
3. If any private moorings are affected by the marina expansion, Herreshoff Marine Museum will pay to have mooring(s) relocated to an approved location
4. The engineer on record will coordinate with any DOT projects or other projects in the construction area of the marina.
5. Adequate parking be resolved as required.
6. Bathroom and restroom requirements be addressed.
7. The marina schedule of construction be presented to the Town of Bristol.
