**AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT TO  
CHAPTER 17  
OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BRISTOL TOWN CODE**

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of Bristol, Rhode Island, that Chapter 17 of the Ordinances of the Town of Bristol be amended as follows:

**CHAPTER 17 – OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

**ARTICLE II – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ESTABLISHMENTS**

Sec. 17-82. - Number of licenses.

Alcoholic beverage licenses within the town shall be limited in quantity as follows:

(2) For class B limited, there shall be a maximum of ~~four~~ five licenses;

This ordinance shall take place upon its passage.

The Town Council will be in session in the Town Hall, Council Chambers, on March 11, 2026. If remonstrance in the meantime, a petition bearing the valid signatures of at least twenty (20) qualified voters must be filed with the Town Clerk requesting a Public Hearing, such hearing must be held before final action may be taken on said ordinance.
