

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE RHODE ISLAND STATE POLICE
AND
THE TOWN OF BRISTOL**

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("Agreement") is entered into by and between the Rhode Island State Police ("RISP") and the Town of Bristol ("Town") regarding access and Use of Flock License Plate Reader (LPR) Camera Data.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this MOU is to establish guidelines and restrictions regarding the Outside Agency's access to, and use of FLOCK automated license plate reader (ALPR) camera data owned and operated by the Rhode Island State Police. This MOU is intended to ensure responsible use of ALPR technology in accordance with the policies, procedures, and privacy expectations of the State of Rhode Island and its residents.

SCOPE

This MOU covers all access to and use of Rhode Island State Police-owned FLOCK ALPR cameras and associated data. The outside agency may be granted limited access for investigative and public safety purposes under the conditions outlined below.

CONDITIONS OF ACCESS

Authorized Use:

Access to FLOCK LPR data is granted solely for law enforcement and public safety purposes, including but not limited to criminal investigations, active searches for stolen vehicles, missing persons, or suspects in serious crimes.

Prohibition and Data Sharing:

The Outside Agency shall not share, disseminate, forward, or otherwise provide access to any data, images, or alerts obtained from Rhode Island State Police FLOCK ALPR system to any third party, including but not limited to:

Other municipal or state agencies that have not entered into a substantially similar MOU with the Rhode Island State Police;

U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement or any external agency when the purpose of that agency or request is the enforcement of potential violations of federal civil immigration law; and;

Any private organizations or entities.

Violation of Data Sharing Restrictions:

Any unauthorized disclosure, sharing, or use of Rhode Island State Police FLOCK ALPR data in violation of this MOU will result in immediate revocation of access privileges for the outside agency. Additional administrative or legal actions may also be pursued at the discretion of the Rhode Island State Police and/or the State of Rhode Island.

DATA OWNERSHIP AND OVERSIGHT

All data collected from FLOCK ALPR cameras is owned by the Rhode Island State Police and remains the property of the Rhode Island State Police. Access is granted at the sole discretion of the Rhode Island State Police and may be revoked at any time with or without cause.

The Rhode Island State Police reserve the right to audit all access logs, user activity, and data usage pertaining to the FLOCK system to ensure compliance with this MOU.

TERM AND TERMINATION

This MOU shall remain in effect until terminated by either party with written notice. The Rhode Island State Police may terminate this agreement immediately if the outside agency is found to be in violation of any terms outlined herein.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT

By signing below, the Outside Agency acknowledges and agrees to abide by all terms, including the prohibition on sharing FLOCK LPR data with any external or federal agencies.

GOVERNING LAW

The terms and conditions of this agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Rhode Island.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Rhode Island State Police and the Town of Bristol have each caused this Agreement to be duly executed by its authorized officer as of the day and year first written below.
