- (c) The ballot measure shall clearly state the proposed alternative venue and the reasons for the proposed relocation.

#### SECTION 3. RESOURCES

(a) The Bristol Town Council and Bristol Fourth of July Committee shall ensure adequate allocation of existing resources to support these events, including, but not limited to, safety plans developed by the Bristol Chief of Police; however, in no way shall this allocation result in a levy of taxes.

### SECTION 4. TEMPORARY RELOCATIONS IN CASE OF EMERGENCIES

(a) In the event of a public emergency, natural disaster, or other extraordinary circumstances rendering Independence Park unusable, the Town Administrator, with the approval of the Town Council, may authorize a temporary relocation of the concert series for that year only.(b) Any such temporary relocation shall not be construed as a permanent change in venue.

### **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY**

If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions, which shall continue in full force and effect.

### SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and adoption.
