**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF BRISTOL,
RHODE ISLAND AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF INDEPENDENCE PARK AS THE PERMANENT
VENUE**

(a) The Bristol 4th of July Concert Series shall be held exclusively at Independence Park, located at Thames Street, Bristol, Rhode Island, except as otherwise provided in this ordinance.

SECTION 2. MODIFICATION OF VENUE SUBJECT TO VOTER APPROVAL

(a) Any proposal to relocate the Bristol 4th of July Concert Series from Independence Park to a different venue must be approved by a majority of Bristol voters through a ballot measure during a general or special election.

(b) The Town Council may initiate such a ballot measure only after holding at least one public hearing to solicit input from residents.

(c) The ballot measure shall clearly state the proposed alternative venue and the reasons for the proposed relocation.

SECTION 3. RESOURCES

(a) The Bristol Town Council and Bristol Fourth of July Committee shall ensure adequate allocation of existing resources to support these events, including, but not limited to, safety plans developed by the Bristol Chief of Police; however, in no way shall this allocation result in a levy of taxes.

SECTION 4. TEMPORARY RELOCATIONS IN CASE OF EMERGENCIES

(a) In the event of a public emergency, natural disaster, or other extraordinary circumstances rendering Independence Park unusable, the Town Administrator, with the approval of the Town Council, may authorize a temporary relocation of the concert series for that year only.

(b) Any such temporary relocation shall not be construed as a permanent change in venue.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance is determined to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions, which shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and adoption.
