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Description of proposed work:
Proposed work on the exterior of 48 Constitution Street Apartment #2 (second & third floor of the building) will include the addition of a new aluminum skylight in the owner's third floor bedroom to bring more natural light and provide better ventilation and air quality in the space. The skylight, a Velux Manual Venting Curb Mounted Skylight System, will be installed approximately 17' from an existing skylight in the roof and will match the existing skylight and asphalt shingle roof in color (grey). In addition to the skylight, a new roof cap dryer exhaust fan (plastic, black finish) will be installed in the roof below the existing skylight for proper ventilation of a new third floor laundry room.
