

Dear Honorable Council,

Recently, I conducted an extensive study of Sec. 16-343 (Residential Parking Zone) of the Bristol Town Ordinance. As a result of my study, it appears that the streets listed in sec. 16-345 as residential parking streets are properly posted. I was unable to locate any information contained within any of the sections of the ordinance relevant to parking that defines what the downtown parking zone is therefore a change to the current language is appropriate and necessary.

In sec. 16-~~343~~ (b) (1), it is the Police Departments recommendation to redact the current language that reads "The downtown parking zone which is limited to one hour; and" and replace it with the following:

1. State Street between Hope Street and Thames Street which is limited to one hour between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., except Sundays and legal holidays; and
