- 3. Report of the Harbormaster:
  - A. New Marina Status: Electric: temporary power available, expect 30 & 50 amp service around 1st week of June. Transformer in late August or September. Water will be on before long, pump out in, skimmer due. Church St. power (existing) will be on.
  - B. State St. Ramp & Indy Park Launch Docks: Work continues; cleat missing from wall at State St; Indy on hold, ground testing showing possible bad soil.
  - C. Dock Repair: 12 rebuilt floats to this point, 10 Rockwell, 2 Church St.
  - D. Sign: With Town Administrator/HDC, probably installed during May
  - E. Marina Wait List: 163 at present
  - F. Gibson Rd ROW & Ramp: still in process, budget issues, fall earliest
  - G. Town ROWs: No current update
  - H. Fales Rd ROW: No current update; one hole repaired, another created
- 4. Breakwater Study Committee: Army Corp looking for ways to fund it; getting input from second engineer on Silver Creek project, different types of installs are available. Fishermen express concerns about affects it could have on water quality.
- 5. Elks Club: No letter received at Council to date; number of slips sought more like 2 or 3 rather than the 8 previously reported.
- 6. PI Ferry Parking: Many options have been considered and described, none appear to appeal to riders to this point. Winter parking accommodations would be welcomed by riders. This item voted off agenda, as it is a Town Council matter moving forward.
- 7. Public Input: Questions of various arrivals onto marina waitlist explained with Gregg's review of prior listings and payments having been made in recent years.
