Notable Activities and Reports from the BCWA Board of Directors April 27, 2023 Meeting

- 1. Interconnection with the Pawtucket Supply System The design of Phase 2 of this project (the northern portion of the pipeline including the routing of the pipeline and connection to the PaWSB system) is about 60% complete. This is a cost-sharing project with the City of East Providence. Payment was received this past month from the City for work completed at the 30% design level.
- 2. Phase I Demolition of the Child Street Treatment Facility It is expected that the contractor will begin in May. This work includes the removal of the exterior tanks and piping.
- 3. Hydrant Flushing Routine annual hydrants flushing has been on going and will in all three towns in accordance with this schedule:
 - a. Week of 4/16 Barrington (Completed)
 - b. Week of 4/23 Barrington and Warren (Completed)
 - c. Week of 4/30 Warren
 - d. Week of 5/7 Bristol
 - e. Week of 5/14 Bristol
- 4. Administration Building Roof Replacement Engineering plans and specifications have been completed. Public bids are being solicited for this project. A pre-bid meeting was held with prospective bidders.
- 5. Website based communication has been expanded and improved with the creation of a project tracking dashboard for this year's water main improvement program. This information may be found on our website at: https://bcwari.com/2023-water-distribution-system-improvement-program-update/
- 6. Procurement and Bid Awards
 - a. Purchase of a Ford F550 Truck Bids for the purchase of this truck (used to support field operations) were received and compared to the state Master Price Agreement pricing for the same vehicle. The state's quote was about 7% less than the one bid BCWA received. Purchase of the vehicle will be through the master price agreement process. This action was approved by the BCWA Board at this meeting.
- 7. BCWA annual report is being prepared and is scheduled to be delivered at the July, 2023 Board meeting.
