CHAPTER 16 – MOTOR VEHICLES AND  
TRAFFIC

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ARTICLE V. – STOPPING, STANDING AND  
PARKING

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**Section 16-160: Designated parking spaces on  
Constitution Street for access to the Urban  
Coastal Greenway.**

(a) Parking at two designated parking spaces located on the north side of Constitution Street, beginning at a point sixty (60) feet east of the seawall at the westerly end of Constitution Street; thence running easterly along the north side of Constitution Street a distance of forty (40) feet, shall be signed as limited to those persons who are accessing the Urban Coastal Greenway. Such spaces shall also be restricted to a maximum of two (2) hour parking, with no parking allowed overnight from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., and no residential parking stickers shall apply to these spaces. Violation of this ordinance shall be subject to enforcement by the Police Chief as set forth in this Chapter.

This ordinance shall take place upon its passage.

The Town Council will be in session in the Town Hall, Council Chambers, on August 21, 2024. If remonstrance in the meantime, a petition bearing the valid signatures of at least twenty (20) qualified voters must be filed with the Town Clerk requesting a Public Hearing, such hearing must be held before final action may be taken on said ordinance.
