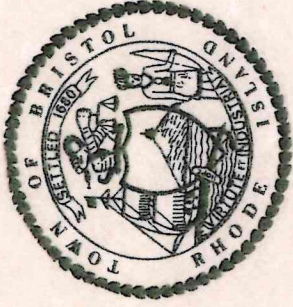


Town of Bristol



Proclamation

Be it hereby known to all that:

WHEREAS, Lagoa was established in 1522 marking the 500th year Anniversary of the Town; and

WHEREAS, Lagoa marks its 10th year Anniversary of Incorporation as a City; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate and maintain a forum for Cultural, Education, and Economic Cooperation, Lagoa, a municipality in the southwestern part of Sao Miguel Island, Azores signed its first local Sister City Agreement in 1990 with the Town of Bristol, Rhode Island; and

WHEREAS, this collaboration of Sister Cities helps support a future where Portugal and United States communities, and its citizens, can come together on common ground and build bilateral ties between nations; and

WHEREAS, the significant impact of the alliance has created more community-led global relationships so that people of different cultures could come together and overcome adversity.

THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Honorable Town Council and Honorable Town Administrator of the Town of Bristol, State of Rhode Island, by virtue of the authority vested in them by the citizens of Bristol, congratulate Lagoa upon this most auspicious occasion of their Anniversaries; and

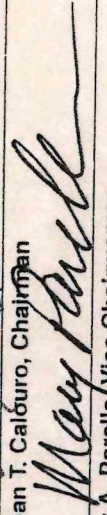

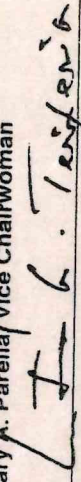

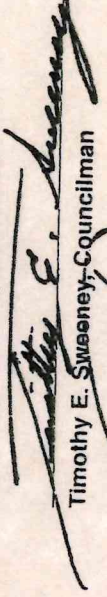
