- ➤ Rescue 4 is in process. Chief DeMello is hoping to have it delivered by July 2023.
- ➤ The delivery of the new Engine 4 is most likely a year out.
- > Asked the board to review the department's SOG'S, and report back with any changes, omissions or additions.

➤ Chief DeMello reported that of this meeting there have been approximately 3700 calls for the calendar year. He appreciates the job well done by all members of the department.
