SUBJECT : INTOXICATING BEVERAGE LICENSE RENEWALS 2022-2023

Sir,

I have reviewed the requests for Intoxicating Beverage License renewals for the listed establishments. The following deficiencies were noted during a department conducted Liquor License compliance check conducted on September 16, 2022, and reports taken for underage drinking during this year:

- Class A liquor license- Mt. Hope Liquors, Violas Liquors, 1776 Liquors sold alcoholic beverages to persons under the legal drinking age. (Compliance check)
- Class BV liquor license- Aiden's and Common Pub each had one report of under aged drinking in the establishment.

Additional action should be considered if any of the listed establishments fail future compliance checks.

There is no know reason for denial of any of the remaining renewals provided that all Law and Ordinances governing this practice are followed.
