AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 17 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BRISTOL TOWN CODE

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Town Council of Bristol, Rhode Island, that Chapter 17 of the Ordinances of the Town of Bristol be amended as follows:

Sec. 17-82. - Number of licenses.
Alcoholic beverage licenses within the town shall be limited in quantity as follows:

(2) For class B limited, there shall be a maximum of five six licenses.

The Town Council will be in session in the Town Hall, Council Chambers, on April 1, 2026. If remonstrance in the meantime, a petition bearing the valid signatures of at least twenty (20) qualified voters must be filed with the Town Clerk requesting a Public Hearing, such hearing must be held before final action may be taken on said ordinance.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
