



RESOLUTION

TO THE HONORABLE RI GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN SUPPORT OF JOINT RESOLUTION 7678

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LINCOLN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS: Joint Resolution 7678 was introduced into the General Assembly on February 11, 2026 by Representative Casey and others; and

WHEREAS: Joint Resolution 7678 creates a nine (9) member joint commission to review and provide recommendations to strengthen coordination between state and local government and who would report back to the General Assembly by December 31, 2026; and

WHEREAS: The joint commission will provide an opportunity for cities and towns to ensure that the experience and perspectives of local government inform decisions made at the statehouse.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF LINCOLN, RHODE ISLAND AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the Town Council of the Town of Lincoln hereby expresses its support for Joint Resolution 7678 and respectfully requests that the Honorable General Assembly enact Joint Resolution 7678.

SECTION 2: That this resolution be forwarded to the Town of Lincoln's legislative delegation, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate.

SECTION 3: THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE BY THE LINCOLN TOWN COUNCIL.
