To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised that, pursuant to RI law, the Town Council of the Town of Bristol will be holding an annual Public Hearing on the request for renewal of the Class B Victualler License of AZJ John Street, LLC. d/b/a Harbor House, to be held on November 20th at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Council Chambers at the Town Hall, 10 Court Street, Bristol, Rhode Island.

The license was transferred to AZJ John Street, LLC, from the prior licensee in 2021. It was granted but not issued due to AZJ John Street, LLC's failure to satisfy the requirements for the issuance of the license as set forth in state law and local ordinance. The Council renewed the license in 2022 and again in 2023. At this time, the Council is requesting AZJ John Street, LLC, to appear and explain why the license should be renewed for a third time, given that the licensee has still failed to satisfy the requirements for its issuance.

You have the right to attend the public hearing with counsel and to present evidence for consideration by the Council. Depending upon the outcome of the hearing, the Council is authorized to deny the renewal application for the license.
