- 3. <u>CRMC</u> Application File # 2023-08-084 dated May 14, 2024 for RI Assent. In hands of CRMC with Council approval of our recommendations.

The full corner Vacant Parking Lot is the recommendation of the Harbor Commission with a 4 hour time limit. Also, overnight parking will be added with a requirement for a special sticker from the Harbormaster.
