3. CRMC – Application File # 2023-08-084 dated May 14, 2024 for RI Assent.

8. Parking Issues – Committee of John McDonald & Peter Silva suggest possible changes to rules. The major change they suggest is to change the time limit from 2 hours to 4 hours. George Burman added to committee and he agrees with the 4 hour time limit. Vacant lot Uses was added to this committee's assignment. The full corner Vacant Parking Lot is the recommendation of the Harbor Commission with a 4 hour time limit. Also, overnight parking will be added with a requirement for a special sticker from the Harbormaster.
9. Committee to Review & Revise Appeals Process – the appointed committee as follows: Steve Janaurio, chairman with Dom Franco, Wayne Gablinski, Michael Tamulaites, Skip Castro & Peter Silva on the Committee. They should report back at the Nov. meeting of the Commission.
