GRAVE PURCHASE FEE SCHEDULE

Effective (tentatively) November 1, 2025

Traditional in ground grave price: \$1,500 (from \$1,400)
*Purchases the Right of Burial for — 1 Full Body & 2 Cremains OR 3 Cremains

Cremation Garden Prices

*Includes the Right to Burial & the Memorial Stone

*Engraving is an additional cost

❖ Monumental Plot	space for 4 cremations	\$5,000 (no change)
❖ Flush Marker Plot	space for 1 cremation	\$1,500 (no change)
❖ Flush Marker Plot	space for 2 cremations	\$3,000 (no change)
❖ Columbarium	space for 2 cremations	\$3,500 (from \$1,500/\$1,800)
❖ Bronze Memorial	space for 1 cremation	\$3,000 (from \$2,000)

NOTE: 20% of all sales is dedicated to the Perpetual Care Fund of North Burial Ground to ensure that the cemetery continues to be financially sound and properly maintained forever.

Cremation Opening M-F:	\$1000.00
Saturday before 12/Allowable Holiday:	\$1200.00
Infant Opening: (under 1 year)	N/C
Disinterment: (M-F only)	
Standard:	\$2,800.00
Cremation:	\$2,000.00

*All burials need to be scheduled with the cemetery office at least 48 hours in advance.

**All burials require an outer burial container.

***All burials require an Interment Order.
