At its regular meeting on October 1, 2025, the Bristol Town Council approved a resolution in support of a legislative amendment to RIGL §44-3-3 to grant a property tax exemption for Blithewold, Inc. for property located at 101 Ferry Road (Plat 165, Lot 007), so long as it remains owned by Blithewold, Inc. and used in furtherance of its nonprofit mission.
